Dog fouling; Streetscene will provide normal bins, those with special lids are only provided in parks. Clerk to contact Mr & Mrs Shenton and ask their views regarding provision and location.

Local Council Day; was attended by Councillor Mason who gave a brief resume of events. Clerk was asked to request minutes and circulate to the council.

Boundary Commission; clerk attended a presentation where the Commission's aims were explained. They are looking at the balance of the County Councillor's wards and corresponding work load, with findings being published during 2011.
