Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on Wednesday 13th March 2024 at Hyde Lea & Coppenhall village hall.

01: The chairman welcomed those present and the meeting started at 7.00 pm.

02: Apologies; had been received from, Parish Councillors Ms J Wilkes, County Councillor Mr M Winnington and also from Ms E Carter Borough Councillor.;

03; No interests declared, or dispensations requested on agenda items.

04: Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 10th January 2024.

05: Report on matters arising from the meeting not covered elsewhere on the agenda;

Hyde Lea bank; footpath damage was caused by the Streetscene on a recent visit. It was recommended that it be reported.

06; Councillor Rose;

Explained that he had put forward a rivers motion asking Severn Trent to be more involved in planning applications following the recent flooding in the Borough. He is also involved with the Ecology officer to encourage more planting of flora and to encourage biodiversity.
